- The meeting commenced with a Treasurer's report, with the following highlights:
  - 125K in the bank. We've collected only 8% of the annual appeal, which is behind last year and budget, but we are similarly behind last year in term of expenses.
    - Collected 12K and spent 13.5K
    - Expected to be breakeven for the year
    - 90 directories sold to date
- We discussed the fact that the directory will be going to print tomorrow, and we should begin distributing copies by the end of the week. The directory includes 7 sponsors, which contributed \$2,300 in revenue.
- On the communications front, we discussed the revamped PA website and extended our thanks to Ying for all of her great work on it. Facebook and Twitter PA views and likes are also up. It was noted that the newsletter may be hitting some spam folders, so it is important that people are aware to look for it.
- Senior dumping event went well and included about 100 students. A sophomore class parent coffee outside the library was also successful.
- The effort to do something for Teacher Appreciation Day was discussed, and Karen is awaiting feedback from Mr. Mastrullo on a date that may work for a gourmet coffee truck or something similar.
- An annual Thanksgiving Luncheon is typically hosted by Student Government for local seniors in the school cafeteria. This year, Bryce McKnight in Food Services is developing a budget for the donation of turkeys and pies that they would prepare. The need to fundraise for this effort and work out the logistics of distributing the meals was discussed.
- Class Government has submitted a list of activities for the year, which Mr. Mastrullo is in the process of reviewing for his approval.
- The volunteers heading up the speaker series have contacted an agency for their assistance in identifying quality speakers.
