- The Treasurer reported that revenues were at 86% of budget, expenses are at 45% of budget. We received the Treasurer's report with regards to account balances. St. Patrick's Day donations were far lower than those for the Thanksgiving luncheon.
- The Grants Committee is planning a new web page to include the history of what we've funded and highlights of their work.
- The Senior Class Reps discussed the planning of their end-of-year events including the "Mask"erade Under the Stars.
- The Junior Class Reps shared that they had a total of 12 parents join their rail trail walk, and they are in the process of planning additional ones.
- The Freshman Class Reps reported that they had a successful parent meeting and are planning another one.
- Four class events are being planned for the Wednesday after April break. They are being planned as 2 hour events from 11:45-1:45PM with food, games, a drawing and prizes. \$2,500/event is budgeted, and Ray believes there should be a nominal admission fee to ensure attendance.
- The PA has initiated the posting of open roles for next year's parent reps and committees.
- Mike and Laurie will be joining the next PA meeting scheduled for April 30<sup>th</sup> at 9AM.
- The community ice cream event is planned for the week of May 3<sup>rd</sup> and is budgeted at roughly \$4k. (1300 x \$3.00 (if we can get))= \$3,900)
- Discussion re: redirecting Parent Hospitality funds toward a community ice cream social was held, membership voted and approved unanimously to redirect these funds for the community ice cream social.
- Outreach to incoming freshman has included the creation of a forum for them to submit questions. A possible event with a panel for a Q&A session is being discussed, and will possibly be repeated in the fall.
- The newsletter will be published today, and the next meeting on May 3 will include voting for the new slate. The final PA meeting of the year is scheduled for June 7<sup>th</sup>.
